

BOUNCY CASTLES

The Hall is not insured for the use of Bouncy Castles inside or outside.

The following conditions must be observed if a “Bouncy Castle” is hired for use inside or outside the Hall. **If these conditions are not met the Hall Committee will not be held liable for any resulting consequences.**

THE SUPPLIER MUST HAVE THEIR OWN PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE
(A copy should be given to the Bookings Secretary prior to the booking of the Hall.)

- An adult representative is to act in a supervisory capacity **AT ALL TIMES**
- Only allow children of similar age and size on the castle at any one time
- Avoid any over crowding and ensure that the manufacturers recommendations for numbers are not exceeded
- Soft gym mats should be positioned to cover any hard surface at the open front of the castle
- Make sure that users of the castle remove any potentially dangerous objects, such as jewellery, buckles, shoes, etc.
- Ensure that the castle is stable.
- Do not allow children over the age of 12 years to use the castle

In addition as well as the above conditions, if used outside:

Ensure that the castle is moored securely to the ground.

It should **never** be used in high winds or wet weather
